#### 4. Principal's Report – Toshi

### 6. Treasurer's Report – Merrilee

- \$9,200 Gaming Grant has been received. Another vote will be needed by the general public to spend the funds.
- General Budget can be voted on this evening.

  - Fall Fling (profit of \$1,670.30)
  - Samosas (profit of \$531.00)
  - Bottle Drive (profit of \$12,536.86)
  - DQ Card Sales (profit of \$25)
  - Discount Savings Card (profit of \$80)
  - Hot Lunch October 18 (profit of \$127.42) ~
  - Nov. 1 Hot Lunch: Panago not paid yet.

- \$2,500 to the Playground account from the Bottle Drive.
- Total bank balance to spend from the General Account (as of June 30, 2021) is \$30,930.48
- Current account totals as of November 8, 2021:
  - General operating account balance BMO: \$14,231.41
  - General operating account balance CIBC: \$20,183.65
  - Gaming account balance: \$12,614.75
  - Playground account balance: \$47,925.16
- Hot Lunch: there are currently 30 unpaid orders. Going forward for future hot lunch dates, orders will be cancelled if not paid in full immediately after placing the order by Hot Lunch cut-off date.
- Hot Lunch orders were down from 300 to 180 orders.

#### 8. <u>New / Old Business</u>

- Question from Tyla to Toshi: Is the school allowing in-person presentations? Yes, but admin needs to look at how to consider adjusting group sizes and the presenter would need to follow health and safety guidelines while in the school.
- Comment from Tyla: available dates for Saleema Noon are in May and June 2022. Toshi advised May 16/17 is preferred and the following dates <u>do not</u> work: May 5, May 10 and May 19.

### General Budget Vote

- The total to spend is \$30,930.48 from the General Account.

- It is proposed that the amount budgeted from the General Budget is \$29,461.40 and is as follows:

- PAC to think of ways to give Applewood Nissan recognition for the sponsored hot lunch. It looks like it will be pancakes from McDonald's. Tegan's father-in-law could also walk around outside classroom windows as the "big red guy" on this day.
- Question from Tyla: can we hold a special meeting to vote on the gaming funds? Tegan advised yes, either in December or January 2022 depending on scheduling.
- Comment from Toshi: there is school remedy that will be spent on more Chromebooks. Teacher/staff request for gaming budget would be more classroom Bluetooth speakers and audio FM systems.
- As per Toshi, Sports Day is a leadership day planned by grade 7's, therefore it is requested that the PAC not budget for a special sports day event. There are liabilities in regard to having bouncy castles and other activities on school property during school hours. Perhaps the PAC can allocate these planned funds towards another community event, much like the Fall Fling? The Executive PAC will discuss options and follow up with these plans.
