Meeting Minutes

Purpose: To review meeting with Lily Potter (Principal) and Stephanie Matheson (Vice Principal) about funds requested for school and vote on budget

- Budget meeting is usually completed in August each year for allocation of funds but in 2022/23 year, the principal and many PAC members were new so we were unable to meet until now.
- There are funds for this year not completely allocated and what is required for next year has also been discussed

1. Reviewed previous notes Feb 24th meeting & Budget

- Origami Friday April 14th: Leane leading. Parents requested a change, staff requested not a Friday in the past but (P) & (VP) are ok with Friday.
- Collection & resale of spirit wear: "Vintage Sale". Will advertise via social media
- Murals: Facebook groups have been active. Also repainting ground for 4 squares
 - Verena to research murals & artists
 - Alysha will reach out to a friend
 - Tyla will reach out to city/district about the cement
- Outdoor toys for recess/lunch: better not to ask parents as school wants good quality.
 - Alysha: look for storage bin
 - Mme Storey: husband is a handyman & she has offered to assist with building items, possible solution to put bin on casters if needed
 - Tegan: look into wedding sites for extra large games
- Gaga Ball Pit: \$600 from english bluff, purchase walls, ground & second pit (school wants 2, intermediary & primary). Biggest hurdle to decide where it is placed
 - Tegan to email English Bluff & walk around Ladner Ele grounds with (P)/(VP)
- Curtains: School wants us to handle, not go to the district. Company provided by (P), they need to come to review for a quote & to see if the track needs to be replaced. Min 5K
 - Tegan to forward email to Alysha to follow up
- School wide play: School stated not at christmas time but a different time throughout the year would be great. Suggestions include Al Pitchler retired, Delta Youth Theater
- Bonhomme school wide event

Stephanie noted at the DPAC meeting that they can carry gaming funds over max 3yrs if there is a specific item. Tyla responded we did this for the playground.

- IPads cannot fund as if they are broken or need to be replaced then PAC must fund.
 Better to let the district handle it as we cannot allocate a reserve budget for issues.
- Library has requested to be allocated some funds next year

2. Vote Extra Gaming Funds for 2022/23 year: \$3000

- \$1500 Gaga ball pit (\$600 english bluff & supplies): 10/10 in favor passed
- \$1500 Carry over for the curtain. May need deposit this year: 9/10 in favor passed

3. New/Old Business

- Treasurer position: Merrilee reached 4yrs & as per bylaws must change
 - 2 volunteers but due to time commitments, one does not want to fundraiser or volunteer for events, other is volunteered by a person's spouse
 - Merrilee can continue if voted in but she can only continue for 2yrs due to child's age, good to have someone come in to train now
- 9 new languages in the school: Hot lunch has made "how to" videos. Leane to add to weekly newsletter
- School water issues: lead in pipes. There are specific water stations & kids know they
 are not to drink from the taps. School/district is supposed to be testing the drinking
 water annual, unsure if this happens.
- Upcoming Fundraisers:
 - Neufelds end of March
 - Purdy's for Easter
 - Popcorn monthly
 - Origami April 14
 - Smash & Tess: after Easter April 17-23. Usually delivered directly to the purchaser within a week. Unique link & PAC will receive a percentage of all funds, sale items included
 - Online auction May 12-19. Lauren/Leane emailing, Tegan collecting & storing, Maria will set up website
- Verena suggested to have "handbook" or sheet write up for each fundraiser so that it's easy to replicate in future
- Alysha suggested a virtual session for parents: picky eaters & intuitive eating with Jenn Missena, north vancouver \$500. Stephanie advised DPAC will cover up to \$600 if we have 2 other PACs involved. They will research & apply.
